Your Excellency,

You are kindly asked to start the procedure of verification related to regularity of the aid project to judicial institutions of Serbia, financed with the funds of the European tax payers. The project is called "Capacity Building of the Directorate for Confiscated Property and Improving the System of Criminal Asset Confiscation Re-Launch/Publication Ref:Publication ref:[EuropeAid/131934/C/SUP/RS](#), **and inform us of the results of investigation.**

After the recently held round table dedicated to the fight against the corruption in Serbia, representatives of judiciary have informed us that the mentioned **European aid program was rigged according to the wishes of the representatives of the Executive Branch of Serbian Government**, who are now controlling the confiscated property worth around 500 million EUR, for already known contractor. **At the request of representatives of Serbia's executive branch of Government, the request related to existence of safety standards and protection of personal data was omitted from the tender documentation !?**

The European Parliament resolution on Serbia dated 29.03.2012, regarding more than half of conditions which Serbia will have to fulfill are connected to establishment of impartial and independent judiciary

On 13.04.2012, at the press conference, the MEDEL representatives have stated their disastrous findings of unsuccessful reform of judiciary in Serbia proper. Not only did the reform of judiciary contravene the basic European ethical principles and Bill of Human Rights, but it **has converted the institution of independent judiciary into mechanism of frightening** and last line of defense of institutional corruption and misuse of office.
