On.29.July.2014, we have informed you in detail and with supporting documentation regarding the misuse of the funds of European tax payers at Serbia's National Employment Service.

dated 08 August 2014, you confirmed our allegations and advised that you will take necessary steps in communication with the Serbian Government and notify us accordingly.

After the expiry of 90 days, your response has still not arrived, but we have received a letter from the National Employment Service with which the Anti-Corruption Agency (composed with the monetary funds granted from European Union public funds) agrees, in which it is asserted as follows (document attached hereto).

- European Union Delegation, disposing independently of the EU public funds, without consulting with the end user, was deciding and delivering the goods which the end user neither needs nor uses.
- European Union Delegation is cognizant of the fact that "Comfort Letters" of the users are a usual forgery needed for formal justification of spent EU public funds/money, irrespective of actually achieved results.
- European Union Delegation knows that the monitoring of successfulness of the projects financed from EU public funds exists on paper only.
- Because of the above described attitude of the European Union Delegation, management of the National Employment Service of Serbia had to redo the whole project again and spent for that substantial amount of money from the public funds of Serbia.

odgovoru 08.08.2014 potvrdili ste naše navode i naveli da će te u komunikaciji sa Vladom Republike Srbije preduzeti neophodne mere i o tome nas obavestiti.

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Posle 90 dana Vaš odgovor nije stigao, ali je stigao je odgovor od Nacionalne službe za zapošljavanje sa kojim se slaže Agencija za borbu protiv korupcije (napravljena sredstvima javnih fondova EU) u kome se navodi (dokument u prilogu pisma):

- Delegacija Evropske Unije u raspolaganju sredstvima javnih fondova EU je samostalno, bez konsultacije sa korisnikom, odlučivala i isporučila dobra koja korisniku niti trebaju niti koriste.
- Delegacija Evropske Unije zna da su „izjave o zadovoljstvu“ korisnika uobičajeni falsifikat nužan za formalno pravdanje potrošenih sredstava javnih fondova EU, bez obzira na stvarno postignuti rezultat.
- Delelegacija EU zna da monitoring uspesnosti projekata finansiranih javnim fondovima EU ne postoji osim na papiru.
- Zbog opisanog ponašanja Delegacije EU, menadžment nacionalne službe za zapošljavanje je morao ceo projekat da radi od početka i za to potrošio značajna sredstva javnih fondova građana Srbije

Iz ovog obrazloženja jasno sledi da su građani Srbije duplo oštećeni. Potrošenim sredstvima javnih fondova EU dobili su štetnu pomoć koji su morali ponovo da plate iz budžetskih sredstava



From the above explanation it follows that damage had been inflicted upon Serbian citizens twice. From the spent public funds of the European Union Serbian citizens have received harmful assistance which they will have to pay again from Serbia's state budget.

Above described model of abuse of EU public funds is constantly present in Serbia proper and easily proven through numerous examples- 270.000.000 EUR was invested in introduction of new information system of Serbian public health-care system but the information system in public health care still does not exist even after 12 years and there are also no basic legal grounds for it. EUR 50.000.000 has been invested in reconstruction of 20+1 hospitals in Serbia but renovated hospitals are not seen neither by physicians who work there nor the patients who are treated therein.

The fight against corruption is one of the basic requirements and remarks of EU institutions to Serbia in the accession procedure. Without resolute and actual actions by EU Delegation, at least in the segment where the European public funds are misused-devalued, any fight against the corruption in Serbia is unsuccessful.
