**PREDMET: ZAHTEV ZA INFORMACIJOM OD
OPŠTEG INTERESA**

Po Pravu datom odredbama Zakona o dostupnosti infomacija od opšteg inteesa molimo Vas da nam dostavite dokumentovanu infomaciju iz koje možemo nedvosmisleno saznati:

1. Objave Lista čekanja pacijenata na radioterapiji sa podacima datuma uputa na radioterapiju i zakazanog vremena terapije, za svaki radioterapiski centar posebno (Novi Sad, Beograd, Kladovo, Kragujevac, Niš), za godine 2009.2010.2011.2012.2013.
2. Broj Potvrda o nemogućnosti pružanja medicnske usluge u roku od 30 dana koje Su izdate pacijenima na radioterapiji, odnosno broj Izjava potpisanih od strane pacijenata o odbijanju uzimanja Potvrde o nemogućnosti lečenja. Tražena dokumenta treba da sadrže podatke iskazane za svaki radioterapiski centar posebno i to za 2009.2010.2011.2012 i 2013 godinu.

OBRAZLOŽENJE.

Radioterapiski centri koji nisu bili u mogućnosti da pruže propisanu uslugu lečenja radioterapijom u roku od 30 dana bili su u Zakonskoj obavezi da pacijentu izdaju Potvrdu o tome

http://www.pravonazdravlje.com/documents/aktivnosti/17_08_2009.pdf ili da dobiju pisanu izjavu od strane pacijenta da on odbija pravo da se leči u drugoj ustanovi (Zakon o Zdravstvenoj zaštiti Čl 33).

Sa znanjem Ministarstva zdravlja i RFZO a zdravstvene ustanove i pored jasne Zakonske obaveze nisu izdavale Potvrde o nemogućnosti lečenja.

**MATTER: REQUEST FOR INFORMATION OF PUBLIC
IMPORTANCE**

According to the right granted under the Law on Access to Information of Public Importance, you are kindly asked to provide us a well documented information from which we can beyond doubt learn the following:

1. The publication of the waiting lists of patients at radiotherapy with particulars of doctor's order for x-ray therapy and fixed time for therapy, for each X-ray center separately (Novi Sad, Belgrade, Kladovo, Kragujevac, Niš) for the years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013, respectively.
2. Number of certificates on impossibility to provide the medical services in a 30-day period which have been issued to the patients undergoing radiotherapy, i.e. number of statements signed by the patients refusing to take certificates on impossibility of medical treatment. The requested documents should contain data for each radiotherapeutic center separately for the years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013.

Radiotherapeutic centers that have not been able to render the prescribed radiotherapy treatment within a 30 day time-period have been under duty to issue the patient a Certificate in that regard http://www.pravonazdravlje.com/documents/aktivnosti/17_08_2009.pdf or to obtain a written statement from the patient that s/he waives the right to be treated in another institution (Health Protection Act, article 33) With full knowledge of the Ministry of Health and Republic Health Insurance Fund despite the clear statutory obligation, medical institutions have not been issuing the certificates on impossibility of medical treatment http://www.healthcareantirruption.org/images/dokumenti/Onkologija_IOV2009/Zapisnik_Odbor_nov.2012/6.%20zapisnik%20zdrav%20LAT.pdf Said medical institutions have been using insufficient capacities to form the artificial waiting lists and have been illegally collecting the money for the "jumping of the waiting lists"

The fact is that ever since 2009, when we pointed out with supporting documentation to both the MoH and RHIF to illegal practice of imperiling the life and limb of the patients for the purpose of generating illicit profit, not a single radiotherapy machine was purchased, which leads us to

Koliko su tražene informacije od interesa za građane
možemo videti i kroz sledeći primer: U Vojvodini godišnje
od raznih vrsta tumora oboli 10.780 pacijenata. Lečenje
radioterapijom propisano je kod 6.550 pacijenata. Ukupni
kapaciteti gde pacijenti mogu dobiti uslugu su dovoljni za
2.500 pacijenata. **4.050 pacijenata nema gde da se
leči**. Kad se ovaj broj pacijenata kojima je uskraćeno
pravo na lečenje pomnoži sa 3 dobija se realan pokazatelj
da u Srbiji godišnje 12.150 pacijenata je nezakonito
uskraćeno za pravo na lečenje. Za period od 5 godina
koliko Ministarstvo zdravlja i RFZO odbijaju da reše
problem oko 60.000 pacijenata je uskraćeno za pravo na
lečenje što kod onkoloških pacijenata znači pravo na
život.

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conclude that the insufficient radiotherapeutic capacities are
the result of intentional corruptive practice. We can see
from the following example how badly needed are the
information of public importance. In the region of Vojvodina,
each year there are 10.780 new cancer patients. The medial
treatment by radiotherapy has been indicated for 6.550
patients. Total capacities where the patients can receive
such therapy are sufficient for only 2.500 patients. **4.050
patients have no place to receive radiotherapy**.
When this number of patients is multiplied by 3 an actual
indicator is obtained that in Serbia each year 12.150
oncological patients are denied the right to medical
treatment.

In a 5 year period since the MoH and RHIF have been
refusing to resolve the problem around 60.000 patients have
been denied the right to treatment which for oncological
patients means denial of the right to life.
