Project Name: Improvement of hospital software and implementation of hospital software in 20 hospitals

Evidence, witnesses, participants: In the file/documentation of the World Bank attached to this Information/Denunciation

Description of fraudulent activities:

- The most favorable/best offer was not selected at the tender despite clearly set criteria.
- The selected bidder is not accredited with the Agency for Accreditation of the Ministry of Health (<http://www.dils.gov.rs/index.php?page=drp&min=1&newsid=131>)
- In Tender terms and Conditions there is no clear description what the product that is acquired must contain

Explanation

„Pravo na zdravlje (Right to Health) is a NGO dealing with protection of medical patients' rights. It is neither the tender participant nor it has any financial or any other gain from this tender.

World Bank in Serbia is financing and managing the projects which are of crucial importance and impact for all citizens. Lack of observance/non-abiding by universal anti-corruption principles of World Bank in selecting the bid, non-defined products that have to be acquired and absence of request for safety standards is the reason for urgent reaction. What is particularly perplexing is the continuity of fraudulent activities.

On 18 April 2011 our organisation filed a documented report/information related to misuse of monetary funds of the World Bank in similar case also connected to DILS. Although more than 5 months have elapsed since then, we have not received a concrete response.

Despite large funds of WB and EU being injected into improvement of the information system of health sector, it actually does not exist. According to the orders of the European Commission ECORYS has made an expertise of successfulness of international projects. In the field of improvement of the information system of health sector, there is a statement: „*too ambitiously conceptualized, scandalously implemented*“. You can get more in-depth
