

on Tuesday (5. 12.) Mr. Andreas Haidenthaler, the councilor of the Austrian Chamber of Commerce in Belgrade, had the planned meeting at the EU delegation in Belgrade. He met Mr. Martin Kern, the relevant Head of Operations.

The discussion was very general because the EU delegation does not allow to talk about any specific tender. This was the precondition of the EU delegation to accept this meeting with Mr. Haidenthaler. Moreover Mr. Haidenthaler explained me that - without proven facts - he hardly can act more concretely. Nevertheless Mr. Kern - who is in charge of 650 tenders - mentioned that our specific tender has been reported to OLAF already, the European Anti-Fraud Office. A reply of OLAF is expected, but no timeline has been mentioned.

Unfortunately this is all what we can do for the moment.
